Join a Prayer Team -

You can join any prayer team and/or the Phoenix Dream Center's 40 Day Prayer Challenge.

Volunteer at local community churches or outreaches -

Volunteering time and effort to an anti-trafficking organization is a great way to contribute to the fight against human trafficking.

Educate and equip your teens and children about human trafficking -

There are many anti-trafficking non-profits with blogs and updates that people can subscribe to, keeping them in the loop of any new information or solutions to human trafficking.

Building Careers -

Providing jobs for survivors, internships, skills training for jobs and opportunities.

Share Social Media on the topic of Human Trafficking -

Share with friends and family. Help your community become aware of the issue. Raising awareness for human trafficking can also get more people involved and interested in joining the fight. It can create a chain reaction, leading to more people lobbying, fundraising and educating themselves. Regardless of what the event is, they are efficient ways to raise awareness for a cause and gain new followers.



Help and Mentor Survivors -

Donate clothes and other goods to shelters for survivors of human trafficking. Also, you can donate your time and encourage.

Learn the Signs of Human Trafficking -

Being educated on signs that could indicate someone is a victim of human trafficking increases the likelihood of reporting and could give a voice to the victims who do not feel comfortable speaking out for themselves.

Health Care Providers -

Team up with non-profit organizations to help with medical assistants.



Fundraising -

Holding a fundraiser and donating the money raised to one of the countless organizations that help to fight human trafficking. Not only giving money to the cause but also brings awareness to the issue. Most organizations working to fight human trafficking are non - profit organizations that rely on donations. Holding fundraisers helps maintain the nonprofits.



Report Any Suspicions -

It is important to know the resources available. Get in touch with your local police station. It is important to look up the emergency phone number of the given country, to enable quick reports should a trafficking victim be spotted.

Donate -

You can donate your time or money to the non - profit organizations to help support the cause fighting against human trafficking.

Host an Awareness Event -

Watch and discuss how human trafficking exists.

Meet and/or Write the Government Representatives -

Let them know you care about combating human trafficking and that you want to help. Ask what we can do to help stop it and what changes can be made.

Encourage Your Local Schools -

As a parent, teacher, or school administrator, to be aware that children are a target. Also, encourage schools to include anti - trafficking in their education curriculum.

Download the Anti - Human Trafficking App -

This will enable you to help combat human trafficking by uploading photos of the hotel rooms you stay in when you travel. These photos can and will be used to determine where perpetrators of human trafficking are committing their crimes.
